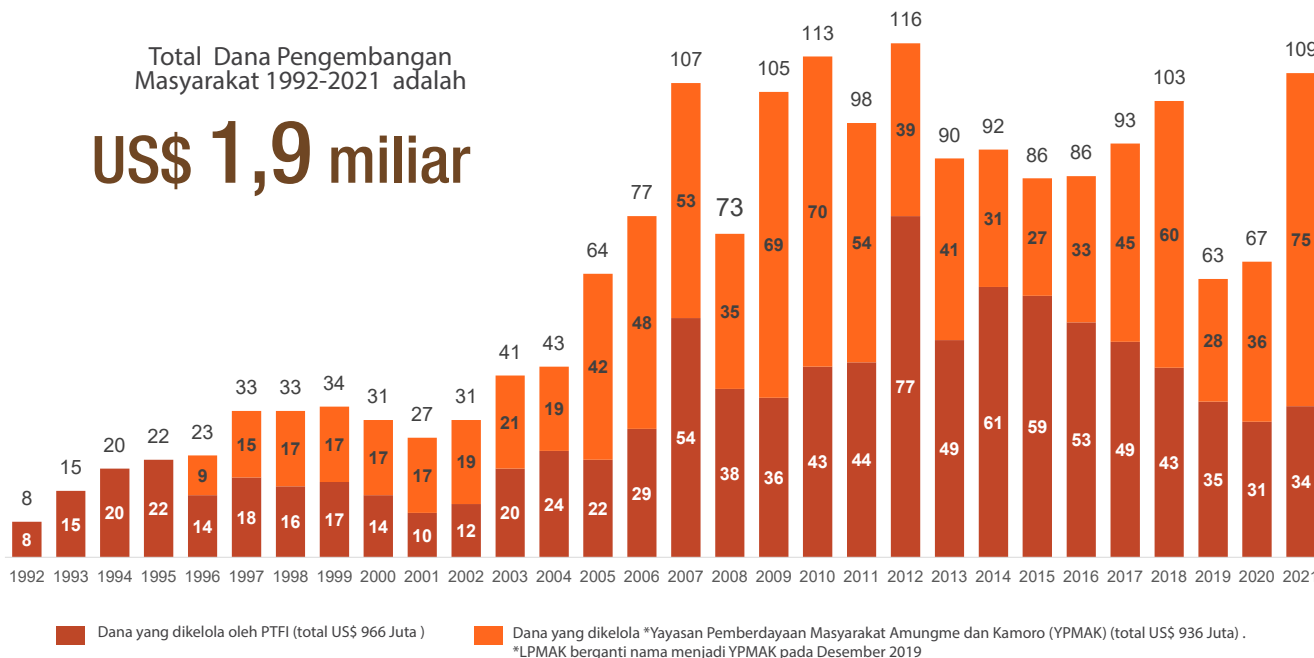


# Pengembangan Masyarakat

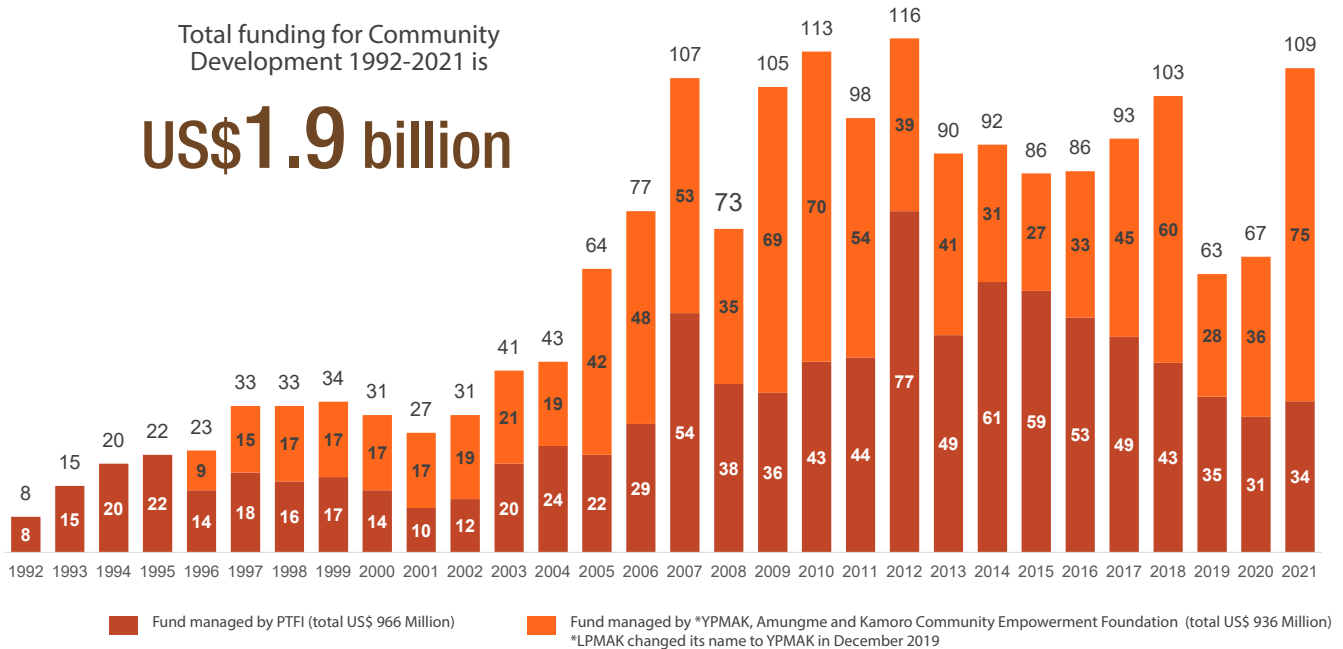
