PT Freeport Indonesia President Director Visits PFA Base

Thursday, 6 April 2023. Mimika Sport Complex was visited by a special guest. PT Freeport Indonesia President Director Tony Wenas had come to the Papua Football Academy base.

Papua Football Academy is a football academy specifically designated for Papuan youths who were scouted in talent searches conducted with full support from PT Freeport Indonesia. In the first year, 30 students passed selection held in three cities, namely Timika, Merauke, and Jayapura.

Tony Wenas arrived at Mimika Sport Complex with an entourage from Jakarta who had come to attend the PT Freeport Indonesia 56th anniversary celebrations falling on 7 April 2023. The entourage consisted not just of the company's management and several former senior executives, but also of senior executives from the national mass media.

Also present were public figures such as Dwiki Dharmawan, Ita Purnamasari, and Andre Hehanussa, all of whom expressed admiration for Mimika Sport Complex and its sport facilities.

On this occasion Tony Wenas heard an account of the current condition and development of Papua Football Academy and the Mimika Decentralized Athletics Training Center, which are based in Mimika Sport Complex, from PT Freeport Indonesia Director Claus Wamafma.

"I constantly follow the development of PFA, the number of youths participating in competitions and the outcomes of the competitions. I have also come to know that PFA students have come to the attention of Indonesian clubs," Tony Wenas said.

Tony recounted a conversation during a recent meeting in Jayapura with Indonesian President Joko Widodo.

"The President specifically inquired how PFA was developing. He shows a great interest in the development of football, including in Papua," Tony Wenas said.
